1. Purpose of the document

The purpose of this document is to provide a general description of the features, functionalities, and considerations of the **GUATEMALA** localization solution for Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central.

The information contained herein does not constitute a commercial offer, contractual commitment, guarantee of regulatory, tax, or legal compliance, or maintenance obligation, and is subject to change without notice. The functionalities described may vary depending on the product version, country, applicable regulations, and the specific context of each implementation and each customer, with the latter being responsible for understanding their own business, processes, requirements, and applicable regulations.

Implementation of the solution requires the active participation of the customer, including, among other aspects, the need to understand and map their processes, business needs, and requirements, as well as to evaluate the suitability of the features described herein for their operation.

2. General scope of LATAM for Dynamics 365 BC

Each of the LATAM localizations developed by AlfaPeople for the countries described on the AlfaPeople website is designed to incorporate additional functionality into Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central in order to support the management of accounting, tax, and operational processes typically required in the various countries of the region.

These solutions are built on the international version (W1) of Dynamics 365 Business Central and can be implemented independently by country or integrated into a multi-country environment, depending on the technological and

operational strategy of each organization and the specific contract signed by the customer.

The localizations complement the standard features of the product without modifying its core functionality, maintaining an architecture aligned with Microsoft best practices.

3. Important considerations

- The features described are a general reference and may require additional configuration depending on the applicable scenario.
- The effective use of the localization depends on proper system parameterization and usage, as well as the correct definition of the processes adopted by the customer, aligned with their operation.
- Any functionality, element, or requirement not expressly described within the scope of each localization is not included.
- The validation of regulatory, accounting, legal, and tax compliance is the responsibility of the customer, as is the verification of any other requirements and functionalities necessary for its operation.
- Any calculation automatically performed by the Localization is based on the information entered by the customer. Therefore, the customer is responsible for the accuracy and truthfulness of the information, as well as for the verification and validation of the results.

4. Architecture and implementation approach

LATAM localizations are designed to operate on a standardized, flexible, and scalable architecture. Multiple countries can coexist within the same instance of Dynamics 365 Business Central, facilitating centralized management, financial consolidation, and the standardization of regional processes.

The implementation of one or more localizations must be evaluated considering the operating model, tax complexity, and regulatory requirements of each country and each customer.

5. Location description – GUATEMALA

The **GUATEMALA** localization for Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central is designed to incorporate functionalities that support the management of tax, accounting, and operational requirements commonly associated with current regulations in that country.

Process	Foreign currency revaluation process	Revaluation of accounts receivable, accounts payable, and bank accounts in foreign currency at the end of each month.
Tax	VAT withholding on purchase invoices	Configuration of percentages and definition of accounting accounts for calculating VAT withholding on purchases.
Tax	VAT withholding on sales invoices	Configuration of percentages and definition of accounting accounts for calculating VAT withholding on sales.
Tax	Income tax withholding on purchase invoices	Configuration of percentages and definition of accounting accounts for calculating income tax withholding on purchases.

Electronic invoicing	Extensive descriptions	Sending of extended descriptions per line in electronic invoicing sales documents.
Electronic invoicing	Mass invoicing	Sending bulk stamping of electronic documents.
Electronic invoicing	Integration with Infile technology provider	Integration with Infile technology certifier.
Electronic invoicing	Standard phrases for tax affiliation issuer	List of standard tax affiliation phrases for issuing electronic invoices.
Electronic invoicing	FACT electronic sales invoice	Main electronic tax document for the sale of goods and services. Issuance from Sales Orders and Sales Invoices.
Electronic invoicing	Electronic bill of exchange FCAM	Electronic tax document similar to an invoice, but with negotiable instrument effects. Issued from Sales Orders and Sales Invoices.
Electronic invoicing	Special electronic invoice FESP	Electronic tax document used for purchases from suppliers who are not required to issue invoices.

Electronic invoicing	Electronic debit note NDEB	Electronic tax document that allows you to adjust values on invoices that have already been issued, increasing the amount owed. Issued from Sales Orders and Sales Invoices.
Electronic invoicing	Electronic credit note NCRE	Electronic tax document that corrects or cancels all or part of an issued invoice. Issued from Sales Credit Notes.
Electronic invoicing	Issuance of DTE with press stamp tax	Issuance of electronic tax document with 'press stamp' tax node. Issued from Sales Orders, Sales Invoices, Sales Credit Notes.
Electronic invoicing	Generation of DTE graphic representation in PDF	Generation of graphic representation in PDF format of electronic documents. (standard format).
Electronic invoicing	Cancellation of electronic documents	Cancellation of electronic documents issued from BC.
Query/Report	Journal	Standard ledger.
Electronic invoicing	General ledger	Standard book.
Electronic invoicing	Inventory and balance sheet book	Standard balance sheet book.
Electronic invoicing	Financial inventory book	Official books required for filing in Guatemala.
Consultation/Report	Sales book	Official books required for submission in Guatemala.
Consultation / Report	Purchase book	Official books required for presentation in Guatemala.
Consultation / Report	Bank reconciliation report	Official books required for submission in Guatemala.

Query / Report	Report on revaluation of accounts receivable, accounts payable, and foreign currency bank accounts	Official books required for presentation in Guatemala.
Consultation / Report	Report on the existence of inventories for sale	Official books required for submission in Guatemala.
